## CENTURY RUN/BIRDATHON 2022

Dear Birdathon Participants:

Thankfully, the pandemic has subsided for now and we happily look forward to the Century Run/Birdathon. We hope you will participate in this activity.

Spring has arrived, the snow has melted, and the peepers are peeping. Our birds are coming back. Who isn't happy to see the first red-winged blackbird or other spring migrants? Birding is a nurturing activity and as John Burroughs wrote: "I go to nature to be soothed and healed and to have my senses put in tune once more".

The Club will conduct the Century Run and Birdathon with a mixture of individual/couple or group activity this year. Your choice. The Birdathon will be on Saturday, May 14th. The compilation of lists will take place Sunday, May 15th at a potluck picnic to be held at Marcia Anderson's house at 2383 County Route 21, Valatie, NY 12184 starting at 4 PM. Hamburgers and hot dogs will be provided.

If you are a former participant, it's time to begin thinking about your sponsors. You will need to create a sponsor sign-up sheet.
