To respect the rights of animals and people who come to enjoy the peace and beauty of this natural area, we ask you to adhere to the following:

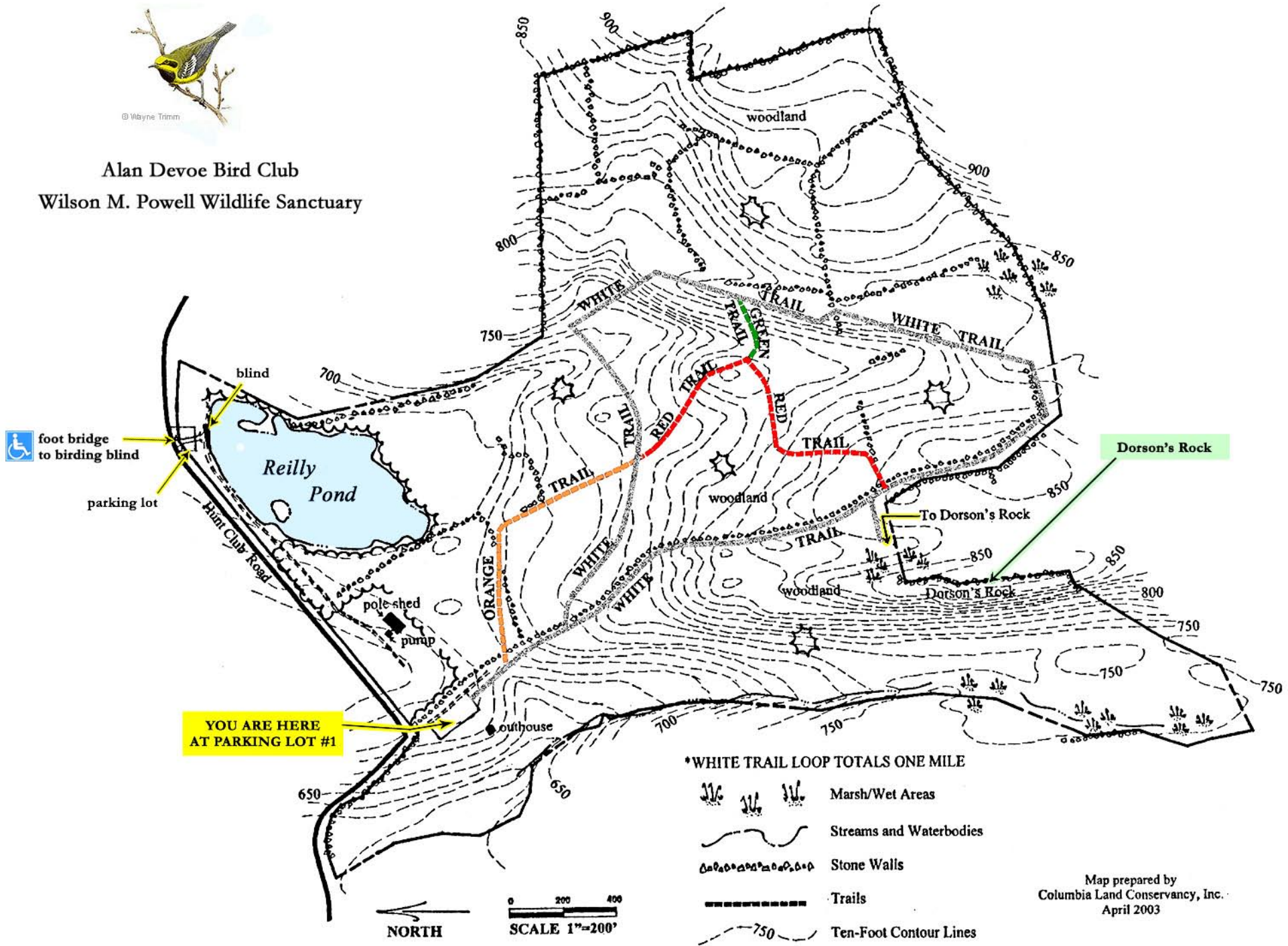
- The Sanctuary is closed to visitors after dark.
- Fires are not permitted at any time.
- Fishing, hunting and trapping are prohibited.
- The Sanctuary is posted and patrolled.
- Firearms are not allowed.
- Leave plants and animals as you find them.
- Do not smoke anywhere on the Sanctuary.
- Persons committing acts of vandalism or disturbances will be prosecuted.
- Motorized vehicles and mountain bikes are not allowed on our trails.
- Dogs are not allowed.

Located off County Route 13, one mile southwest of the intersection of CR 13 and the Old Albany Turnpike (Old Chatham Village Square). Take Pitt Hall Road, then a left onto Hunt Club Road. Sanctuary entrance is on right.






